



Alcohol Policy & Guidelines

JRFC Outcome Statement

To ensure the Johnsonville Rugby Football Club not only meets its license requirements which are critical to the running of the club, but to also ensure we promote a safe and family friendly environment.

General Rule Alcohol is not to be consumed outside of our licensed area.

What is our licensed area?

This includes the upstairs area of the clubrooms only and does not include the green room, changing rooms, car park area and on the park (including the spectator areas).

Why is this being implemented?

As a responsible host it is critical, we ensure we are not only meeting our license requirements, but also ensuring a safe environment at the club. Consumption of alcohol after games in the changing rooms and the greenroom is prohibited as both are alcohol free zone.



Although the car parks are not part of the license requirements, as responsible hosts we will monitor them at random times.

JRFC wants to promote its players, family and friends and invite them to join their supporters in the clubrooms after each match to enjoy our facilities.

What are our licensed hours?

These are as follows and the bar will not be open outside of these hours:

- Monday – Thursday – 6.30pm – 10pm
- Friday – 5.30pm – 12am
- Saturday – 2pm – 12am
- Sunday – 2pm – 8.30pm.

What about bringing alcohol to the ground?

While JRFC is unable to control individuals bringing alcohol onto unlicensed areas, we will however, act appropriately if alcohol has been brought onto the areas specified.

Where someone has taken alcohol up to the ground to watch a game,

The Committee will ask them to move inside our clubrooms to utilise our licensed facility.
